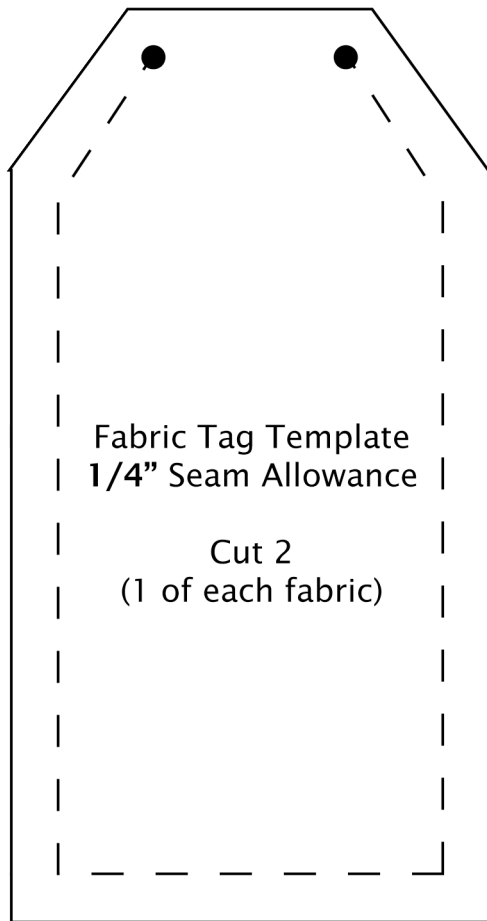


Fabric Hanging Tag Templates



Materials (per tag)

Two 2.5" x 4.75" rectangles of fabric
24" ribbon, cut into two 12" pieces

Directions

1. Design your tag either by printing onto printable fabric or handwriting on solid fabric. You can print the provided tags or design your own.
2. Trim tag front and fabric for back to the size of the template.
3. Place pieces right-sides together and stitch all the way around using the specified seam allowance, except between the dots. Trim and clip corners.

Make sure to anchor or backstitch at dots so seams don't loosen when you turn the unit right-side out.

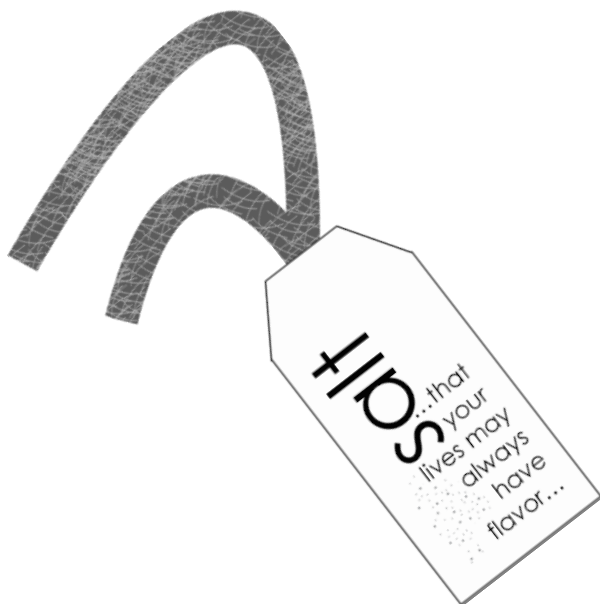
4. Turn the unit right-side out. Press, making sure to keep the seam allowance between the dots folded in.

A point turner or chopstick works wonders for this step, helping push the points out and creasing the seam allowance at the opening.

5. Slide one end of each ribbon into opening at top, then topstitch approximately 1/16" from the edge. Be sure to catch seam allowance at the opening to close it.

You can whipstitch the opening closed if you prefer not to have the topstitched look, although you'll need to make sure to secure the ribbons.

6. Admire your tag!
