

## **Diamond Napkin Ring Templates**





Materials (per napkin ring)

Two 3.75" x 2.5" rectangles of fabric 24" ribbon

## Directions

1. Cut two pieces of fabric to the size of the template. One will be the back and one will be the front.

If you feel comfortable sewing 1/8" seams, you can use the smaller template, which requires 3.5" x 2.25" rectangles instead.

2. Place pieces right-sides together and stitch all the way around using the specified seam allowance, except between the dots. Trim seam allowance to 1/8" if using larger template.

Make sure to anchor or backstitch at dots so seams don't loosen when you turn the unit right-side out.

3. Turn the unit right-side out. Press, making sure to keep the seam allowance between the dots folded in.

A point turner or chopstick works wonders for this step, helping push the points out and creasing the seam allowance at the opening.

4. Topstitch around the edge approximately 1/16" from the edge. Be sure to catch seam allowance at the opening to close it.

You can whipstitch the opening closed if you prefer not to have the topstitched look.

- 5. Align center of ribbon to center of fabric piece and secure with regular or decorative stitching, leaving 1/2" on each side of fabric piece loose.
- 6. Admire your napkin ring!
